# **REQUIRED SHOES FOR RECITAL**

Every student will need to have the shoes required for their class to perform at recital. Costumes all match, head pieces match, SHOES NEED TO MATCH TOO. NO EXCEPTIONS! If you have purchased your shoes for class at Ginny's Dancewear Shoppe then you likely have what is needed for the performance. Every costume will be tagged with which style shoe they will need. This info can also be found on the dress code page of our website. Please make sure you have the required shoes by dress rehearsal. Our store is stocked and we can ensure you get the right shoe with the proper fit.

# **RECITAL PICTURES**

INDIVIDUAL PICTURES will be May 2nd at the studio. You can schedule a time on Sign Up Genius. One time slot per student. (If you have more than one costume, bring them all with you.) The link will be posted on our website along with the order forms. (One form per costume) Please come dressed in your costume with hair and makeup already completed. All orders must be turned in by the end of the day on May 2nd. Allmand Photography accepts cash, check, and charge cards. Individual pictures are optional but are a great memory to capture in a professional photo.

CLASS PICTURES will be taken at dress rehearsal on May 30. Every student will receive a free group photo of their class(es).

# **RECITAL TICKETS**

Tickets go on sale at 9am on May 6th. A link will be posted on our website. Tickets will be available online until May 28th at 11:59pm. Tickets start at \$22, are reserved seating, and non-refundable. It is recommended you buy only what you need in one purchase to ensure your family members sit together. Small children (4 and under) who will be sitting in a parents' lap do not need a ticket. (All electronic toys need to be left at home. They are not permitted in the auditorium.) Tickets can be purchased at the door starting at \$25, provided there are seats available. If you are in need of handicapped seating please speak with the office prior to purchasing tickets.

# DRESS REHEARSAL

**Saturday May 30, 2026**

**LOCATION Jane Tasch Performing Arts Theatre**

**TIME** Each class has a scheduled time. Times will be posted on the parent portal & the website on May 1st. Please arrive at the theatre **15-20 minutes prior to your scheduled time** in your costume with hair and make-up completely done (see below). We will stay on schedule and **will not wait for those who are late**. Students will gather in the hallway outside the auditorium and wait for a staff member to come out and check that all costumes, shoes, hair, hair pieces, etc are done correctly just as they would need to be for recital. Once the students are taken back for their class photo, parents can proceed to the auditorium to watch your child perform. Please collect your child at the side of the stage when they are done.

**HAIR** is to be worn in a bun with bangs pulled back.

**MAKE-UP** is needed to keep your face from getting washed out from the bright stage lights and therefore should be heavier than normal. We recommend foundation, pink blush, pink lipstick and eye shadow of blue, green, lavender or brown. All make-up should be put on at home.

**NO JEWELRY** is allowed on stage. This includes dress rehearsal. Remove all earrings, necklaces, bracelets, watches, etc and leave them at home. **PLEASE WAIT UNTIL AFTER RECITAL TO PIERCE YOUR EARS. You will be required to remove them or cover them with a band aid and both can be painful for the little ones.**

**NAIL POLISH** is NOT to be worn on stage.

\*Requirements for HAIR, MAKE-UP, JEWELRY & NAIL POLISH are the same for both Dress Rehearsal & Recital Performances.

**GENERAL INFO:** DRESS REHEARSAL is the ONLY day you are allowed to photograph/record your child while they are performing. THE USE OF VIDEO RECORDING DEVICES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE THEATRE DURING RECITAL PERFORMANCES. Our shows are professionally recorded. Every student will receive a link to a free digital download of the shows once they have been edited.

# RECITAL

**SUNDAY MAY 31 1pm, 3pm, & 5pm**

**LOCATION** Jane Tasch Performing Arts Theatre

**ARRIVAL TIME** All dancers must use the entrance behind the theatre to check-in backstage **15-20 minutes before** show time. **DO NOT** arrive earlier. Dancers will not be allowed backstage until check in time. Dancers must arrive in costume with hair & make-up done. Only dancers, staff & appointed volunteers will be allowed in the backstage area. Staff members and Leadership Academy students will be at the check-in table to escort your dancer to their assigned room.

**COSTUMES** Label all costume pieces with your name. You must wear the tights that were included with the costume (or the color you are assigned to wear). No other tights or socks are to be worn on stage. NO UNDERWEAR is to be worn under costumes. (Tights are like underwear with legs.) Make sure you have all the pieces and required shoes for any costume changes.

**DANCE SHOES** Bring only the shoes **required** for your dance(s). Leave all other dance shoes at home. As always NEVER WEAR YOUR DANCE SHOES OUTSIDE.

**BACKSTAGE** For the safety of all our performers, no one will be allowed in or out of the backstage area. NO EXCEPTIONS. Backstage doors are monitored at all times. After the finale, **only one parent** will be allowed in the backstage area to pick up your dancer(s).

**THEATRE ETIQUETTE** Please be kind to those around you and to the performers on stage. You must turn off or silence all phones. DO NOT TEXT or play games during the performance. It is extremely distracting to the performers as well as those seated around you. Distractions to the performers can be a safety issue. Please do your best to stay seated during the performance. ABSOLUTELY NO photography or video of any kind in the auditorium during recital. Our show is being professionally recorded and **YOU** will receive a link for a digital download of our shows.

**PLEASE ENTER AND EXIT THE THEATRE BETWEEN DANCES ONLY,  
NOT WHILE DANCERS ARE ON STAGE PERFORMING.**
